Unto you is born a Savior; He is Christ the Lord. Luke 2:11

On Sunday, December 24, we will celebrate this incredible event once again under the theme *Rejoice Evermore*. The theme comes from 1 Thessalonians 5:16, Always be joyful. (NLT)

The apostle Paul knew of the angel's announcement, *I bring you good news of great joy (Luke 2:10.* That is why he is so bold to tell us to "Rejoice always!" This is the Good News for all the people.

This would be very helpful! Until that time, we will rely on the once-a-month noisy offerings, donations from the congregation, and fundraising events.

Next, I have had the privilege of working with several Mount Hope congregational members this past month. These wonderful servants of Jesus have spent many hours helping me put together puzzles to check for missing pieces, sort geometric figures to figure out which sets go together, sort flannel board pieces to make some sense of what we have, clean and wash cupboards, toys and numerous buckets, work on our preschool library, and provide support in whatever way they can. I am extremely grateful for all they have done. Please join me in thanking Holly Traetow, Renata Melbe, Linda Carstens, Laurel Schaefer, Dave Wallin and Kathy Sundseth for their dedication and help with this huge project! I might have given up without their help. It is overwhelming!

Next, I want to thank Christina Brantner for instigating a fundraiser for the New Toddler Room! Christina CAME TO ME and asked if she could hold a bake sale the day of our Preschool Christmas Program. Of course, I happily and wholeheartedly said YES! Besides making lots of baked goods herself, she is also enlisting the help of Jen Schliefer and myself to bake Christmas Goodies for the sale. We hope all of you will support her efforts in this and join me in thanking her for her help. She amazes me with her never-ending energy and support of Mount Hope and its missions!

Other good news... Al Johnson has volunteered to look at building a toddler changing table and cubbies for our toddler room. His woodworking expertise is so appreciated! The cost of one of these tables runs about \$1,200.00 - \$1,500.00 and the cubbies cost another \$800.00 - \$900.00. If Al can build them for us, the cost for materials would not be nearly that high. He is definitely a blessing and we are so thankful for his willingness to look at it!

Someone whose work often goes unnoticed and underappreciated is the church's treasurer. Kirsten Buelow works very hard to make sure all the church and preschool bills are paid promptly, no small feat when we are not doing as well financially as we'd like to be. I am asking all of you to join me in thanking her for her dedication to our church and preschool as she navigates how to pay the bills every month. She has one of the hardest jobs in our church and I an very grateful that she keeps doing it month after month!

Last, but not least, I am very thankful that God sent Allen Petersen to our church as our new office administrator! I Have worked with Allen in several other circumstances in the past and he has always been a friend and a blessing! I look forward to working with him at Mount Hope!
