Ladies, our next Woman of Hope Meeting will be on Saturday, May 11th, 2024 at 10am. We hope to see you there!


Book Club

The feature item for April, beyond April 6th is to replenish household items. Can they count on our support? Laundry detergent, cleaning supplies, and the like.




